Agenda Title: Discuss and review preliminary survey data for the Regional Transportation Plan: Southwest Oklahoma Moving People and Goods.


Background: A survey was developed to collect information to support the Regional Transportation Plan. Surveys were distributed to municipalities, county commissioners, nonprofit agencies, associations, transit agencies, chamber of commerce, other boards and agencies, media, health agencies, nutrition/senior sites. The original deadline was changed from May 17th to June 16th to allow additional time; ensuring that survey results represent the regional population.





Q3 How long is your commute from HOME to work?



Q4 Does anyone in your household have a special transportation need due to age or disability?



Q5 In the last year have you (or someone in your household) missed a medical appointment due to lack of transportation?



Q6 In a typical day, which of the following forms of transportation do you use? (Check all that apply)





Q8 How well does the existing bus/transit services meet your transportation needs?





Q9 How would you rate the following in the SORTPO region?








