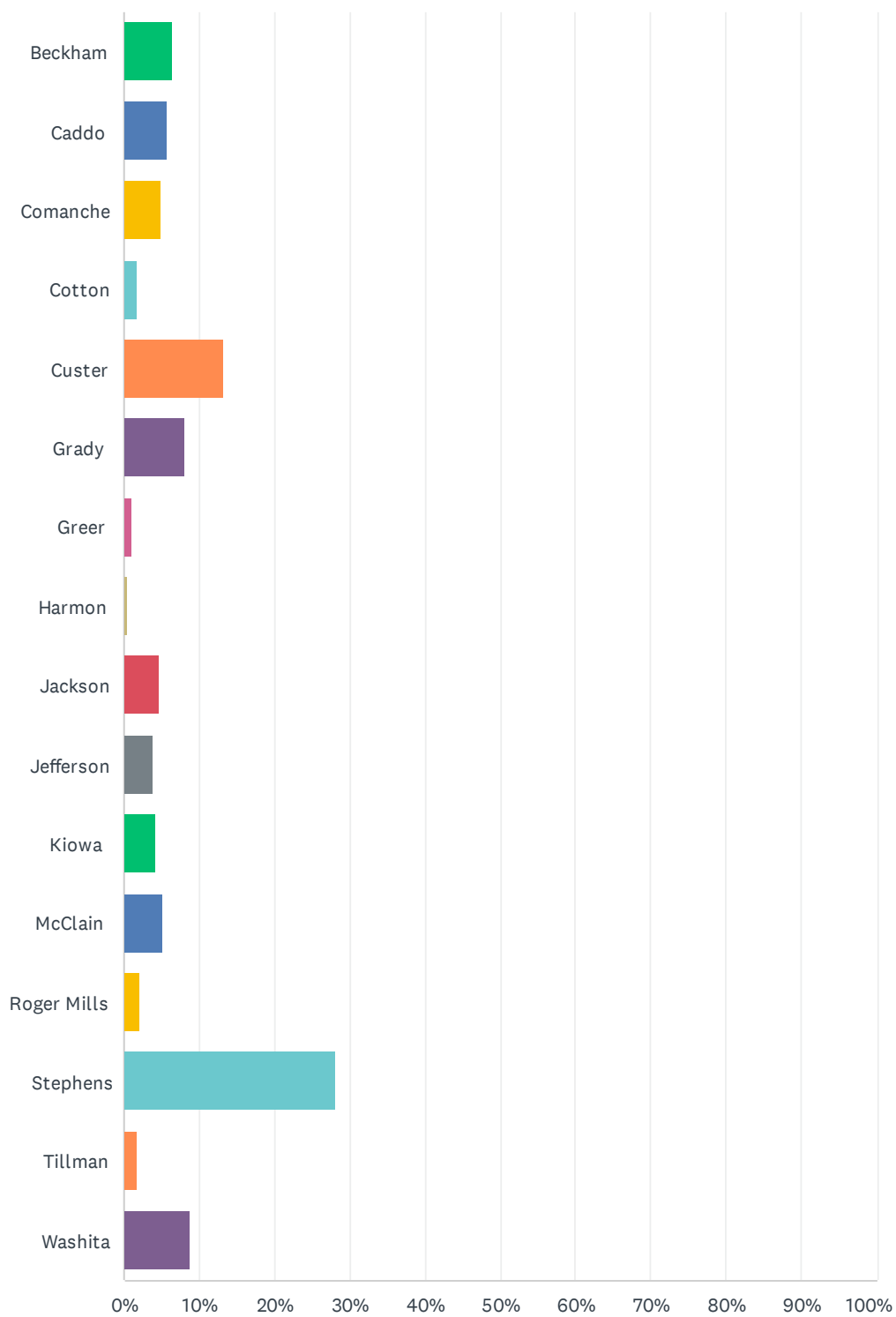


## Q1 What is the county in which you live?

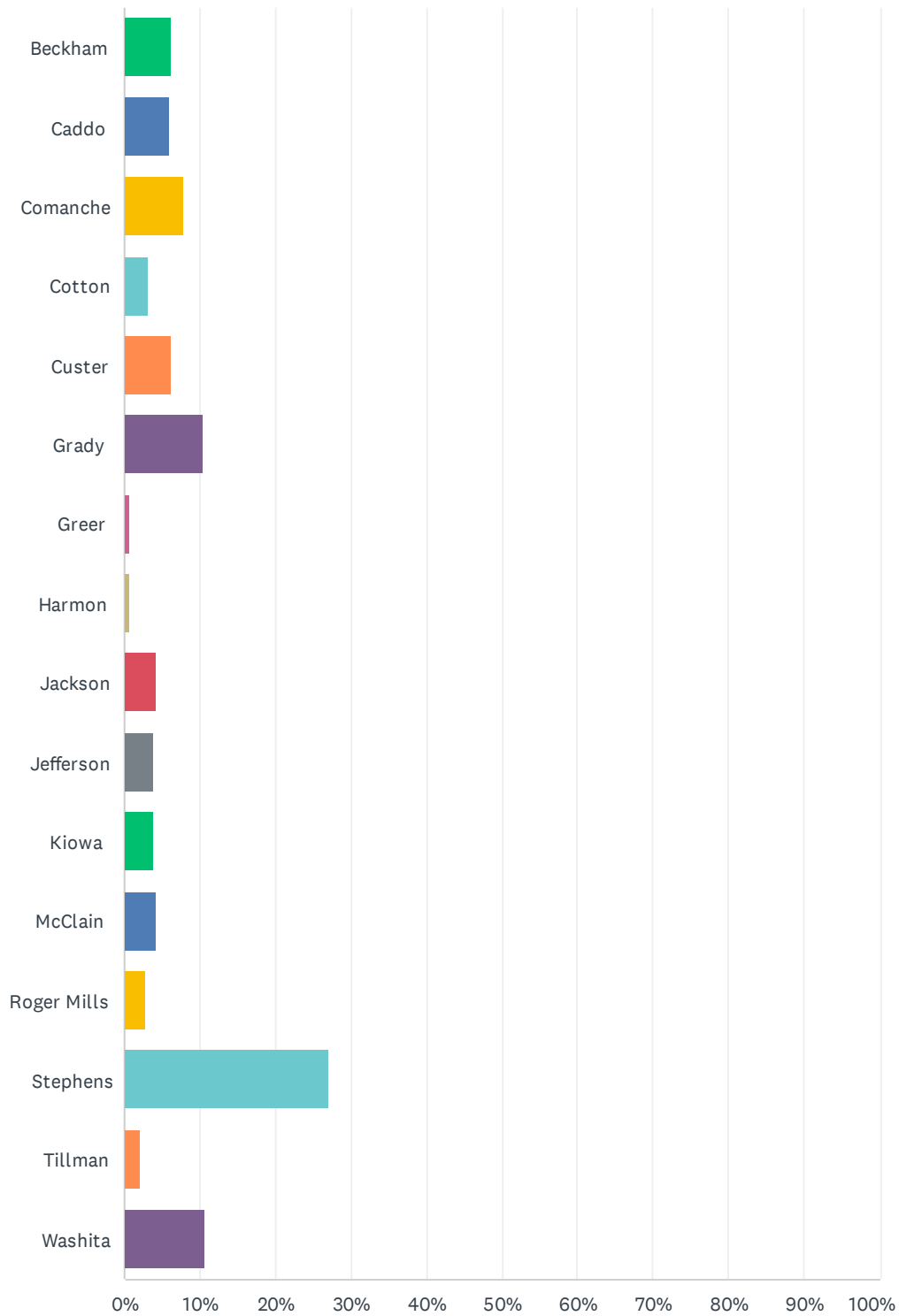

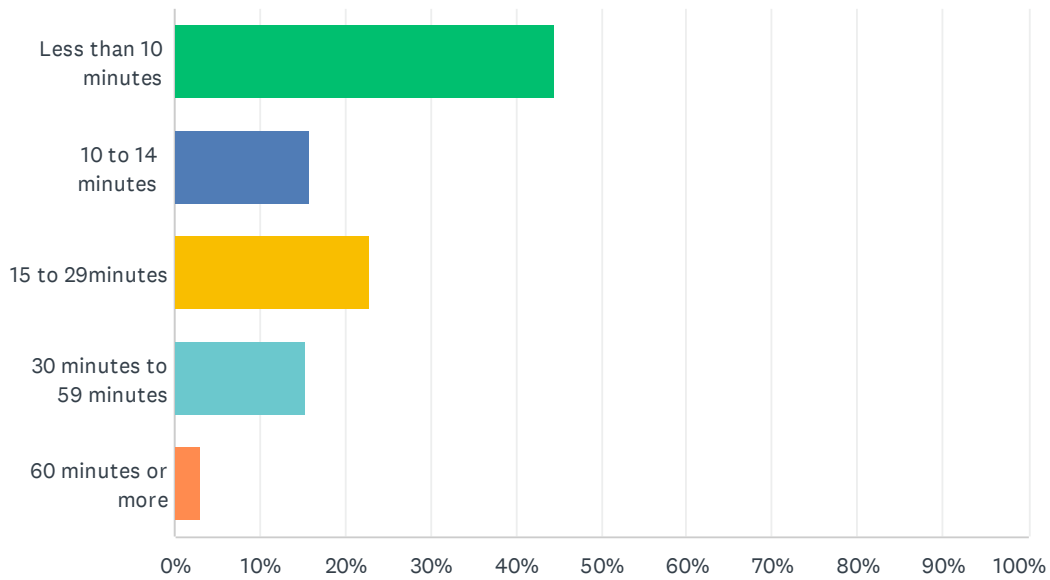

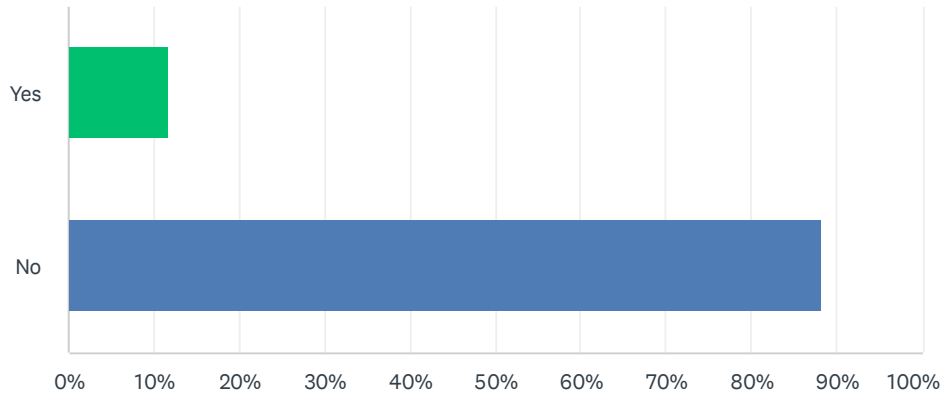

## Q4 Does anyone in your household have a special transportation need due to age or disability?

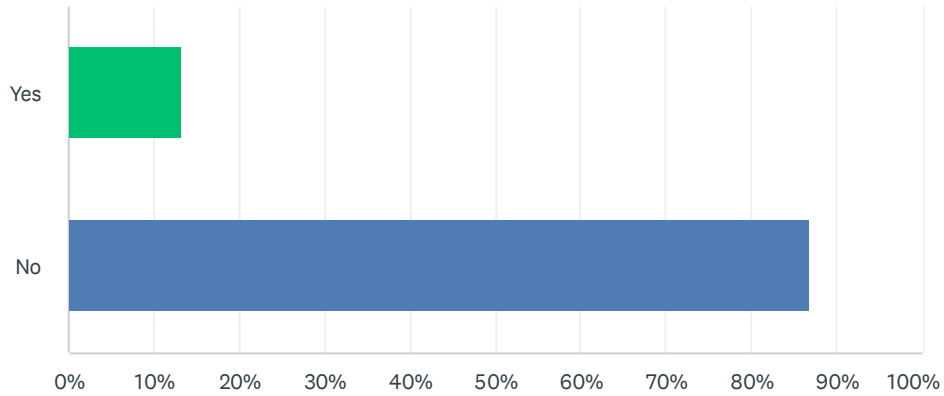

### Q5 In the last year have you (or someone in your household) missed a medical appointment due to lack of transportation?

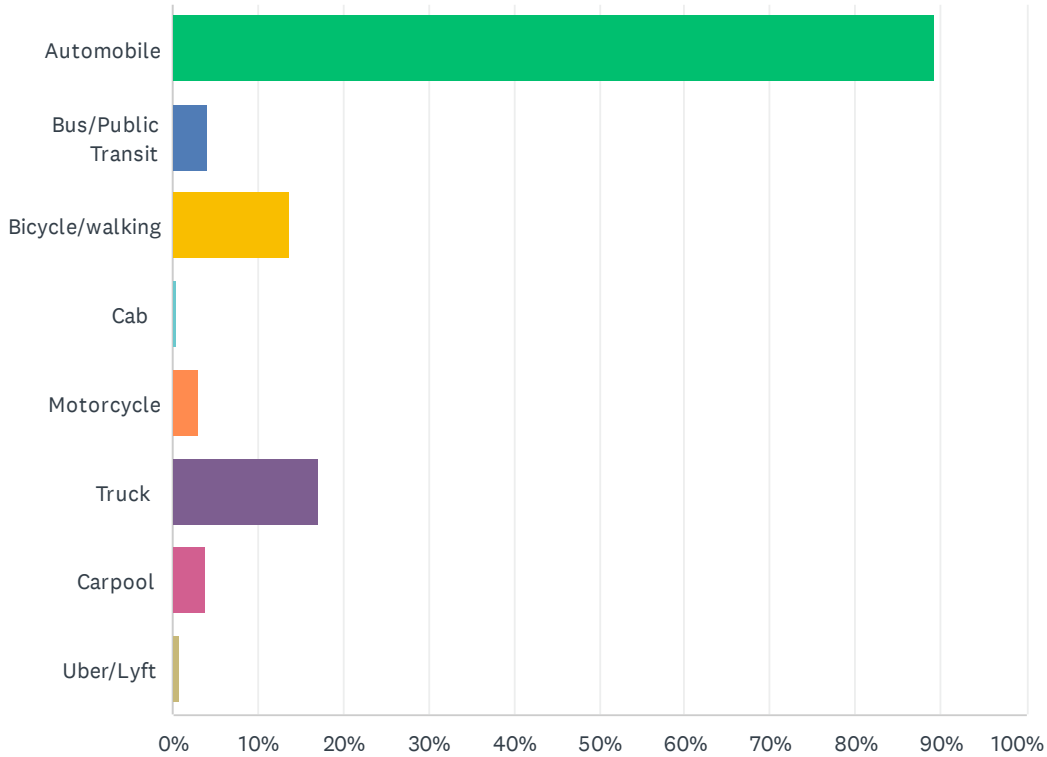

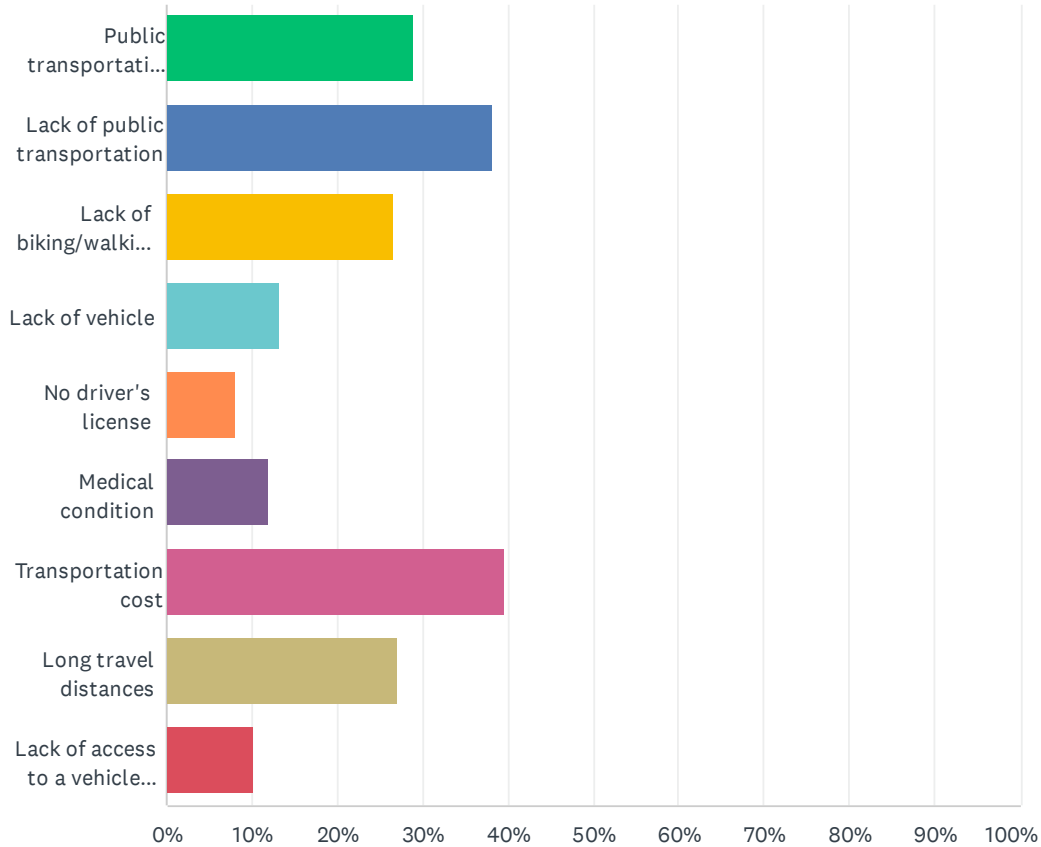

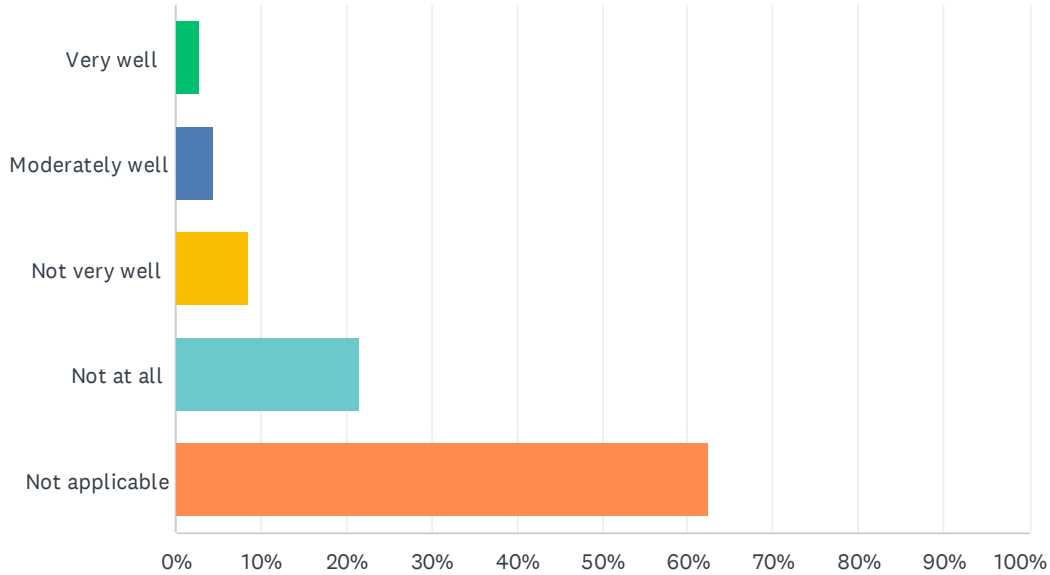

## Q8 How well does the existing bus/transit services meet your transportation needs?

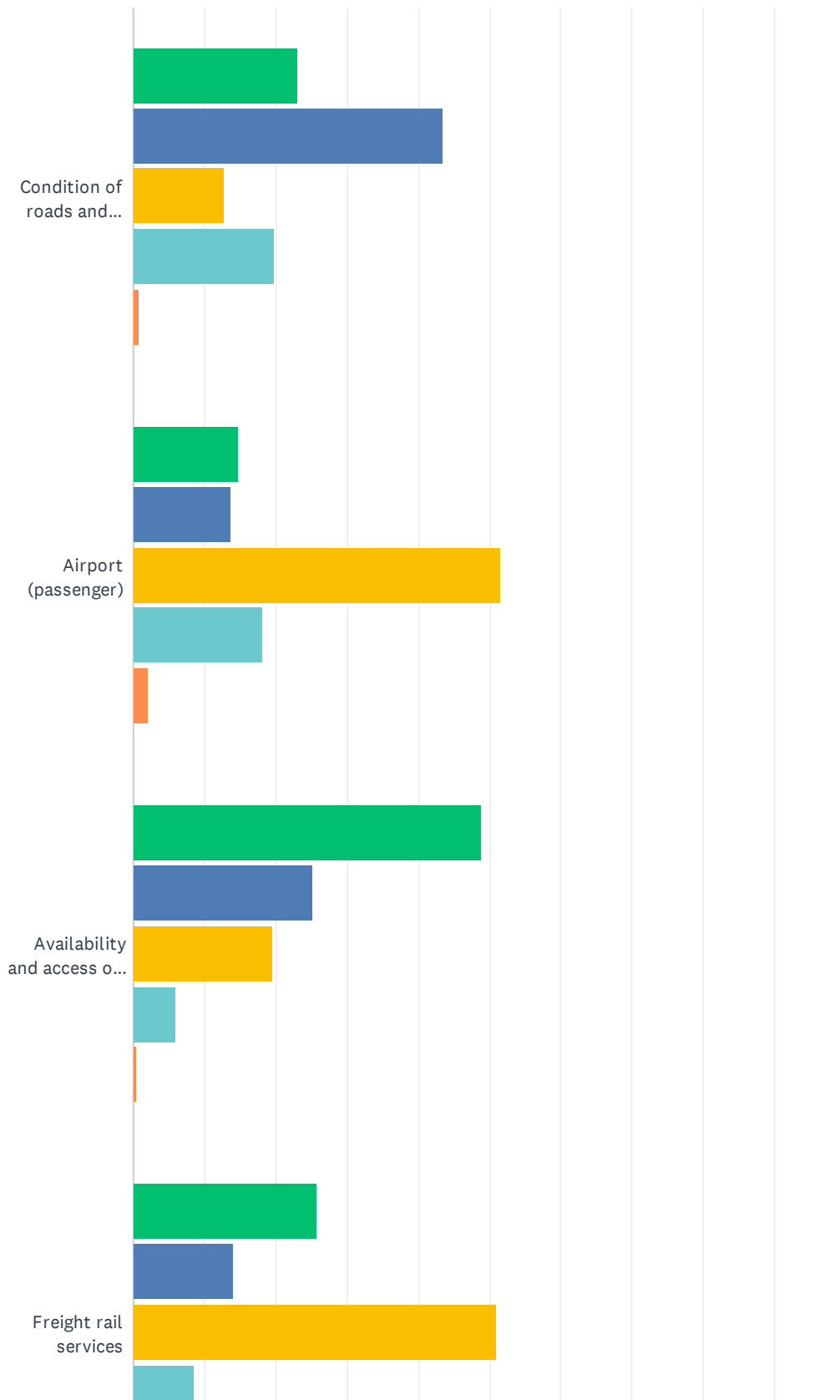

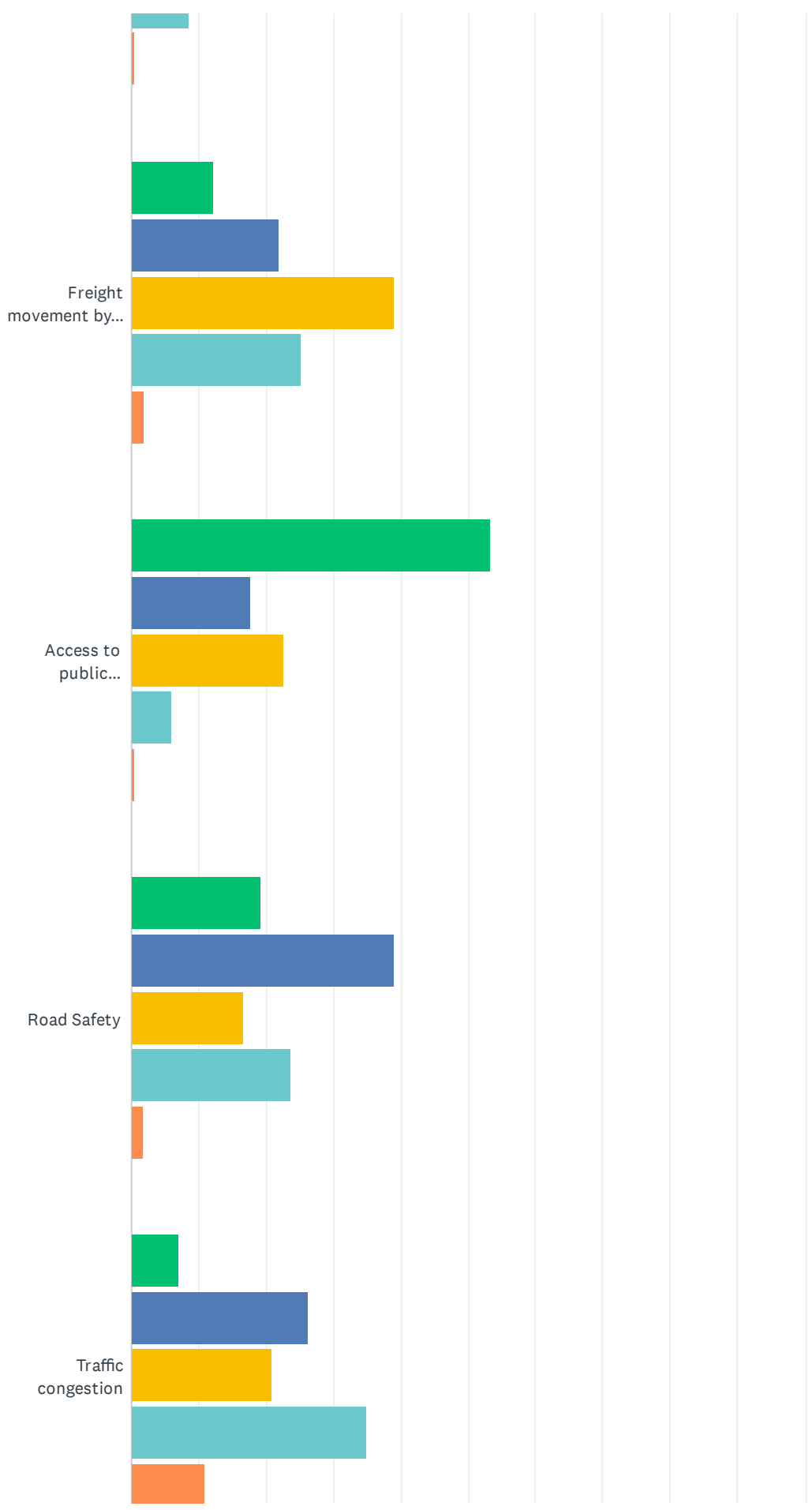

# Q9 How would you rate the following n the SORTPO region?

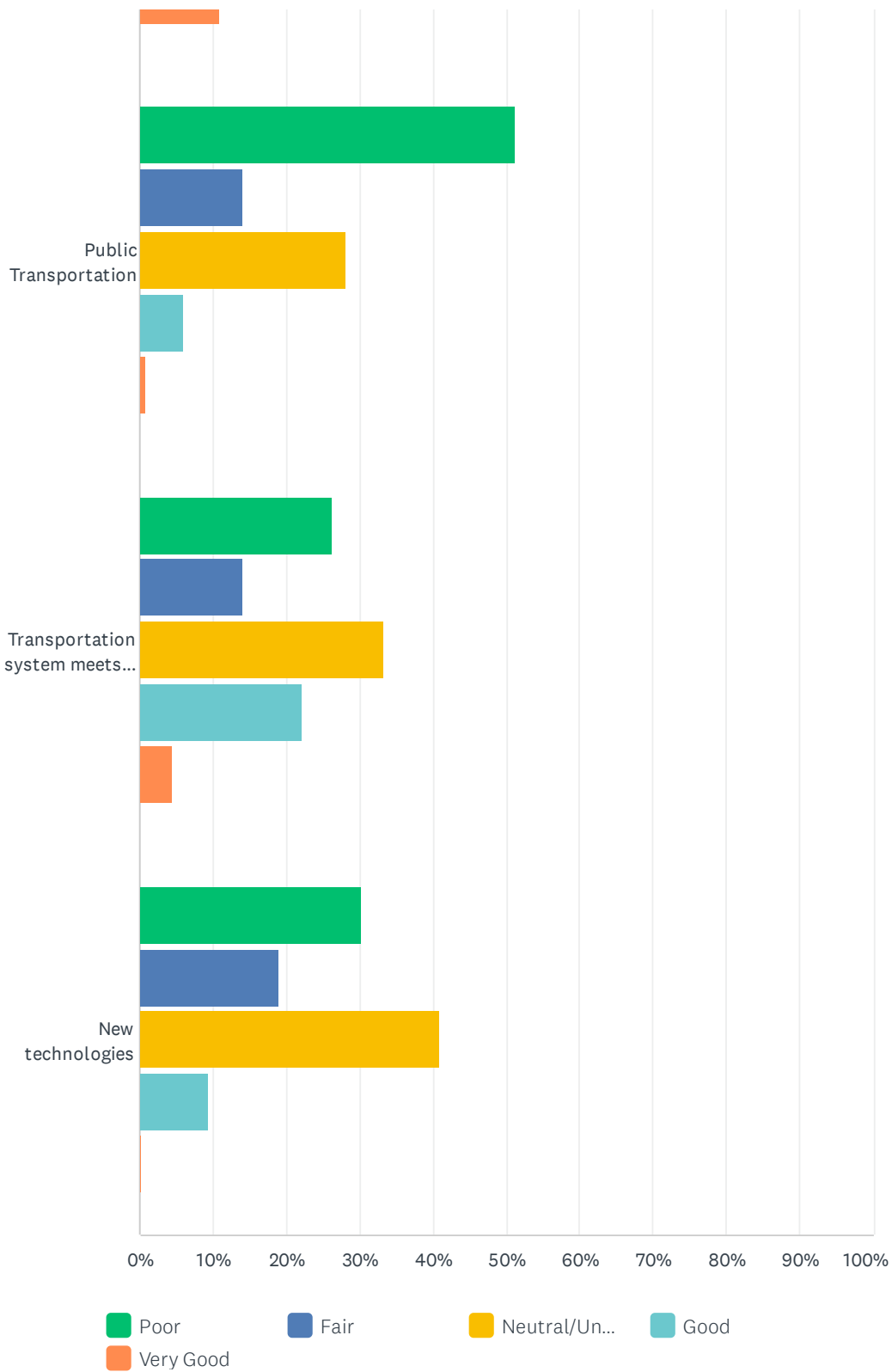

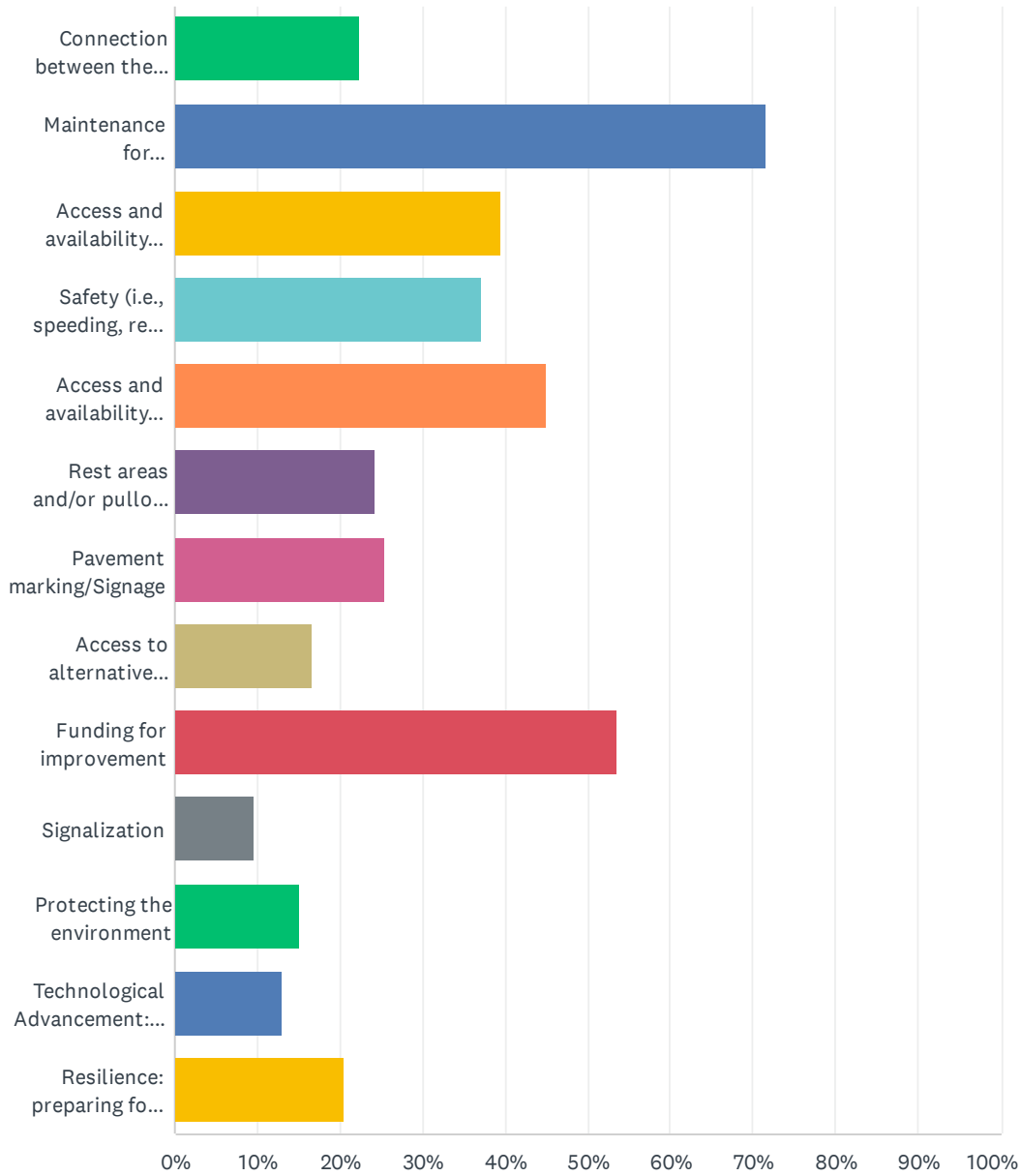

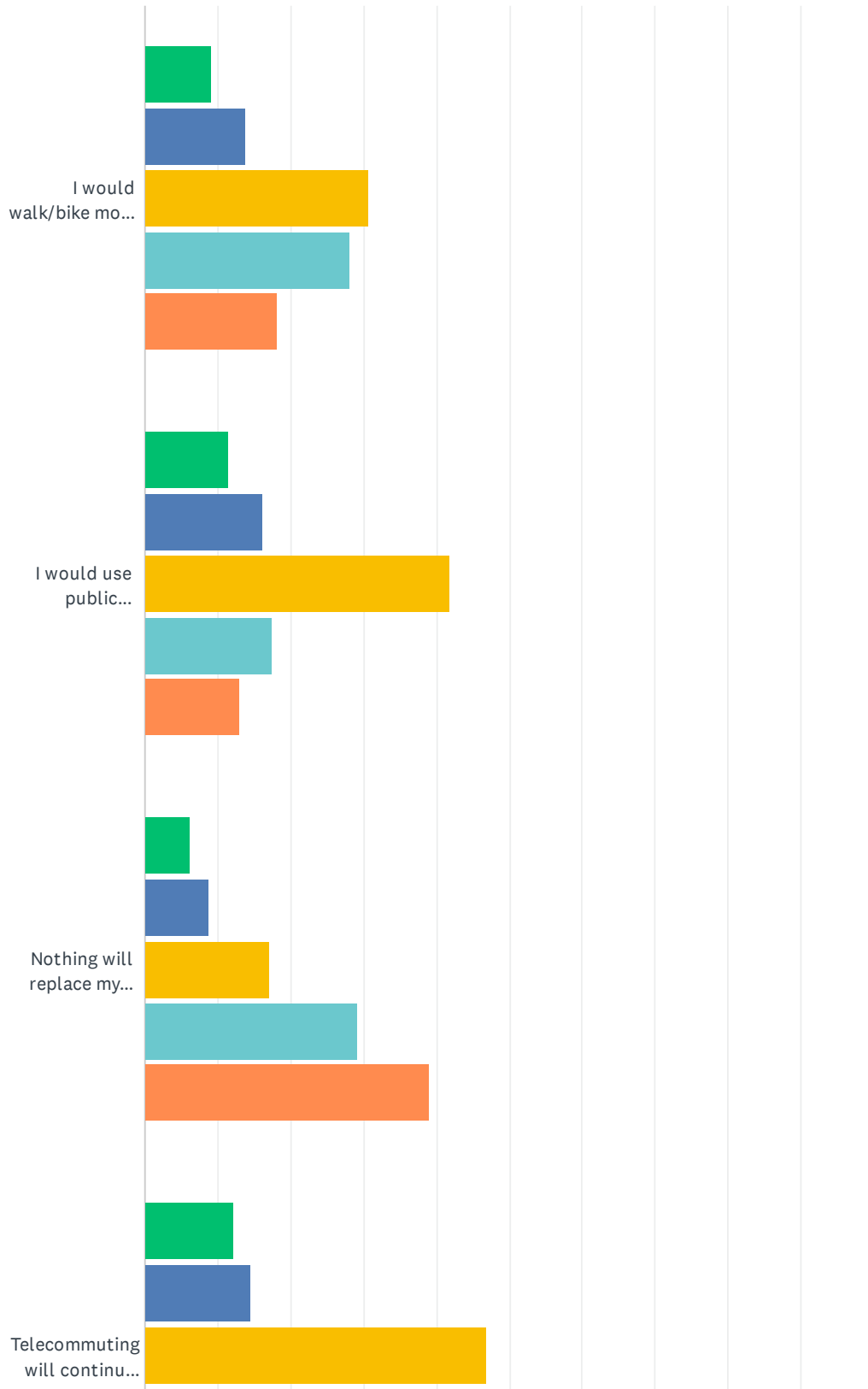

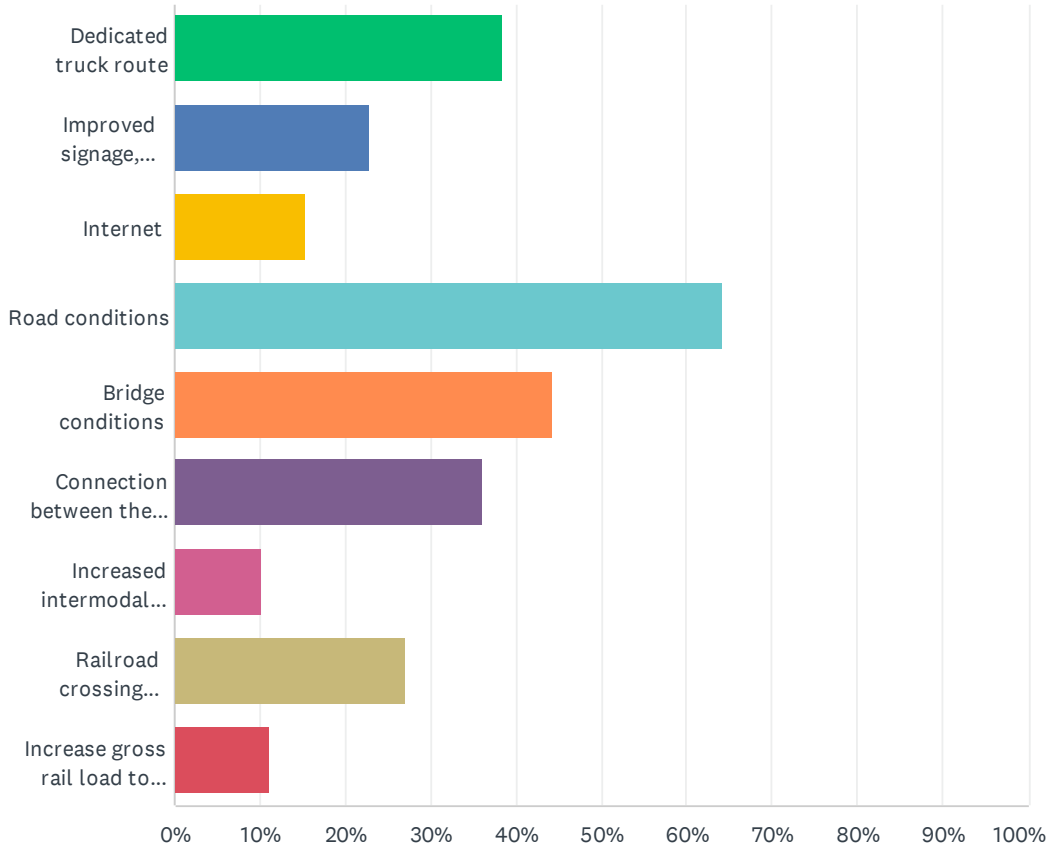

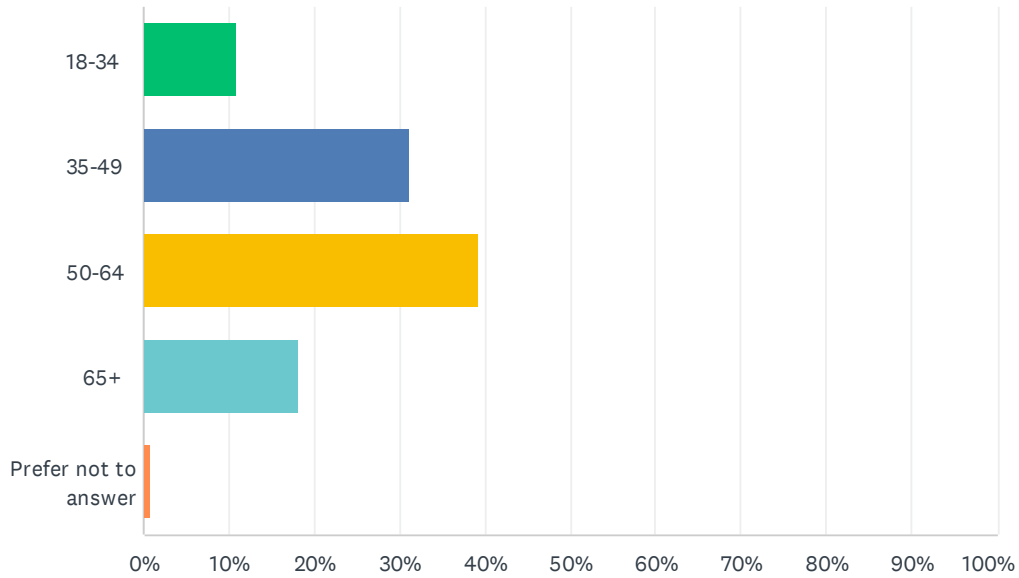

## Q14 Which of the following describes your age?

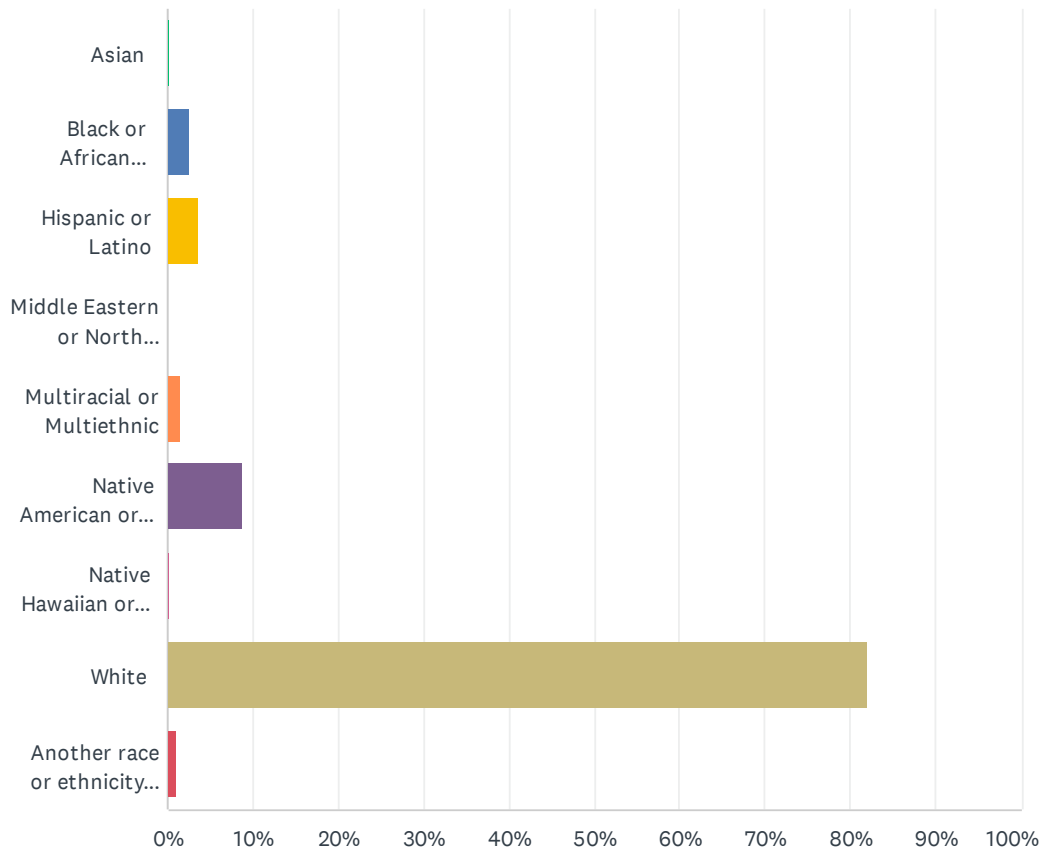

## Q15 What is your race or ethnicity?

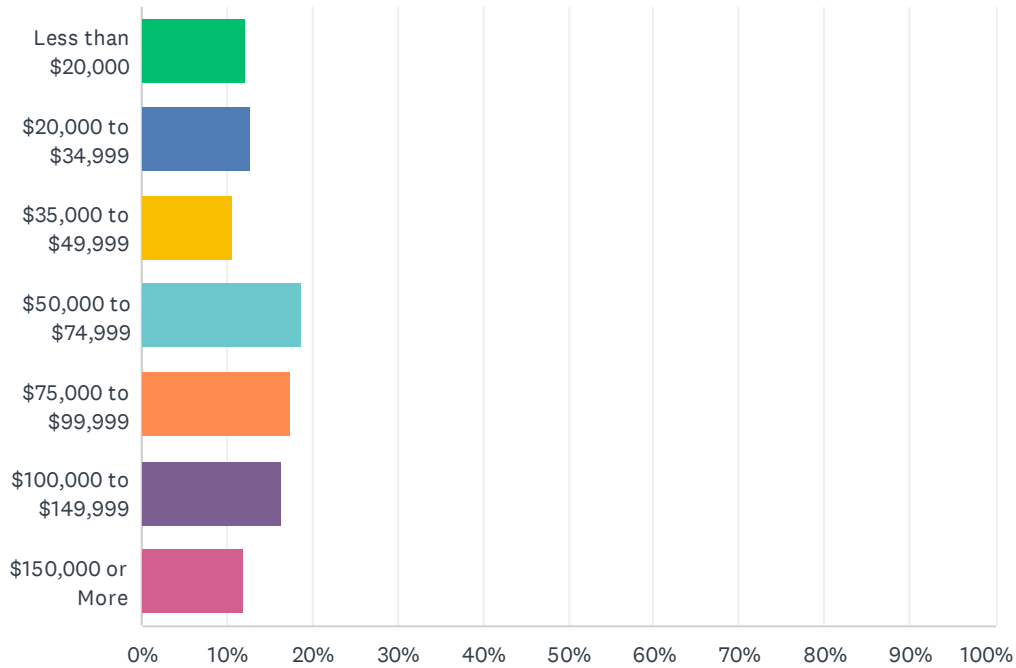
